TITLE: Receive input from Public Regarding Education Code Section 60119 for the Purpose of Encouraging Participation by Parents, Teachers, Bargaining Unit Leaders, and Members of the Community of the Availability of Textbooks and Instructional Materials Consistent with the Curriculum Framework Adopted by the State Board.

Background

Education Code 60119 requires that during any year, in which the District participates in the State Pupil Textbook and Instructional Materials Incentive Program, the Governing Board shall hold one or more public hearings. At these hearings, the Board shall determine, through a resolution after a public hearing, whether each student, including English Language Learners, in each school in the District has been provided, before the end of the eighth week of school, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials, or both, in mathematics, science, history/social science, English Language Arts, (including the English language development component of the adopted program), health in grades 9-12, foreign language in grades 9-12, and science lab equipment in grades 9-12. Sufficient textbooks and instructional materials means that each student, including English learners, has a standards-aligned textbook and instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home in each subject consistent with the content and cycles of the state curriculum frameworks. The Board's determination shall be made in the form of a resolution.
